DIRECTIONS

From Syracuse: Take 81 south to exit 12 at Cortland. Take Rte 281 south which becomes Rte 13 to Ithaca. At the Ithaca Airport (light) take a left on Warren Rd.; at stop sign, take a right onto Hanshaw Rd., turn left onto Pleasant Grove Rd. The Country Club of Ithaca is on your left (about a mile from Rte 13).

From Binghamton: Take 81 north to Whitney Point. Take Rte 11 to Rte 79, turn left on 79. Follow Rte 79 to Ithaca. Turn right onto Rte 13. Follow Rte 13 for about 3 miles to Triphammer Rd.; turn right at the light, go to stop sign, veer left, make a right turn onto Pleasant Grove Rd. (4th right). The Country Club of Ithaca is on your left (about a mile from Rte 13).

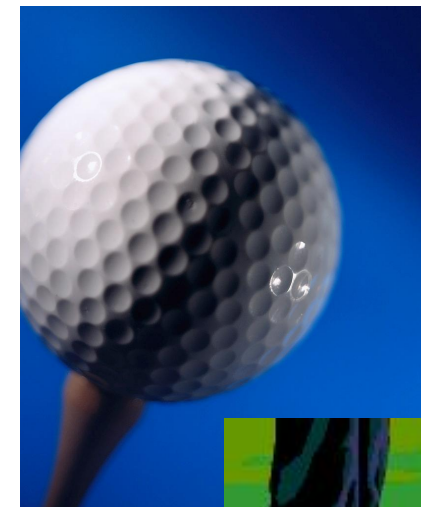
From Rochester: Take the Thruway to Geneva/Ithaca exit. Take Rte 96 to Ithaca to Rte 13. Turn left and follow Rte 13 for about 3 miles to Triphammer Rd.; turn right at the light, go to stop sign, veer left, make a right turn onto Pleasant Grove Rd (4th right). The Country Club of Ithaca is on your left (about a mile from Rte 13).

JOB DESCRIPTIONS FOR 4-H GOLF

OPEN VOLUNTEERS

SET-UP (6:00 am—7:00 am)

Help to set up silent auction, signs, work areas, easels, and other assignments as needed—before tournament players arrive.

SET-UP (10:00 am—12:30 pm)

Help set up awards table and make sure everything is in order in the dining room.

GREETERS (6:30 am—8:00 am)

Greet all arrivals, giving them directions to the pro shop, registration table, breakfast, rest rooms, and answering any other questions that the golfers might have.

REGISTRATION (6:30 am—8:00 am)

PARTICIPANT REGISTRATION

Verify who is attending, collect unpaid fees, handout score cards, program booklets, participant gift, and flight list.

SELL MULLIGANS

A mulligan ticket is an extra shot that can be used any time in the round, that is purchased for \$10 at registration.

SELL SKINS

Team-purchased 50/50 chance, best team score per hole without a tie; sells for \$20 at registration.

SELL RAFFLE TICKETS

For a 50-50 cash raffle, awarded during the luncheon.

PHOTOGRAPHER (7:30 am—finish)

Take informal, posed team, and award presentation photos.

HOLE SPOTTERS (8:00am—10:30 am or 10:00 am—approx. 1:00 pm)

A hole spotter is assigned to monitor each par-3 hole where a contest is under way—hole-in-one, closest to the hole, and closest to the line. The spotter should station him or herself close to the green but out of harm's way. The spotter should verify participant closeness and/or holes-in-one, making sure requested information is completed on the markers.

SELL RAFFLE TICKETS (12:15—1:00)

For a 50-50 cash raffle, awarded during the luncheon.

SIGN REMOVAL (1:00 pm—3:00pm)

Remove Tee/Green, and Hole-In-One signs and stakes. Deliver to The Wood Office after luncheon.

TROPHY HANDOUT (1:00 pm—3:00pm)

Hand trophies to top-placed team members.

BREAKDOWN (After guests leave 3:00 pm)

Help pack items that need to be returned to the office.
